....From Pastor Gary Kinkel

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Summer has gone by quickly! But it has been eventful. At the top of the list of events is Pastor Linda's acceptance of a call to be the solo pastor of a congregation in Houston, MN. She has done good and faithful work here. Her ministry at St. John's has been an important mainstay during a time of transition. I am grateful for the generous and open way in which she received me. She has been tremendously helpful to me as I continue to find my way in a new congregation and its unique rhythms. I know there are many to whom she has given support, counsel and always prayer. As she leaves for Houston we send her with blessing and prayer for her new work and home. Together we say to Pastor Linda, "Go with God!"

Meanwhile, as we gear up for the fall, please be aware of two adult discussion opportunities. First, the ELCA is working toward a social statement regarding Gender and Justice. An important component of this involves congregational conversations of the issue. Beginning on September 18 there will be a discussion of the issues—using the ELCA resource. It will take place during the education hour between services. Sara Oliver will lead the discussion. We are still in the process of working out where it will meet. But it is your opportunity to engage with others, to grow by hearing what others think—and how they think—and to let your voice be heard on the issues. Please consider being a part of this important process.

The second opportunity will take place simultaneously with the first (again, the exact space to be determined). The second will be a discussion and engagement with the book, Reading the Bible with Martin Luther. Both of these adult discussions will happen over a matter of weeks, or perhaps months. But the general plan is to complete these by about Advent and then plan a new set of adult discussions to span the winter and spring.

Taking part in such a discussion is not only a chance to grow in understanding. It is also a good chance to get to know other St. John's members better and to let them know you. It is an opportunity to make new friends and connections and to be drawn more deeply into the lives of sisters and brothers in Christ. I sure hope we get to see you in one or the other. If there is something you would like to see discussed, please let me know!

A note from Council...

Grace and peace to all those working in God's church. Here is a brief outline of some projects that St. John's council is leading at this time.

- It is September and the Spiritual Formation team is busy building a family of teachers, staff, and students for the Sunday school year. They are collecting registrations for Sunday school and planning for an open house event on Rally Sunday. Registration for the confirmation program is also open, and plans for Wednesday night simple suppers, small groups, and Summit Worship are taking shape.
- In a joyful collaboration between the Finance and Spiritual Formation teams, the Stewardship Team meets each month to learn, plan, and pray together regarding stewardship at St. John's.
- The Properties and Management team is collecting bids on a project to replace some nonfunctioning ballasts in the older part of the building.
- The Social Concerns team leads the Loaves and Fishes meal each month, feeding as many as 100 plus people at the St. Mark's cafeteria. They are also working to build a network of volunteers to support our worship servant opportunities.
- The council held a special meeting in August to learn of Pastor Linda's call to Cross of Christ Lutheran in Houston, MN. The
 council shared her joy in this new phase in her ministry, and expressed their sadness in her leaving St. John's. The council will be
 in constant conversation in the next few months regarding next steps in staffing and ministry.

Thank you for supporting the council as they seek to learn and grow as followers of Christ.

- Fall Planning Discussed vision on what is St. John's is now and what will it be ten years. Looking to collect data from the congregation and plan a volunteer pot luck night.
- Leadership Seminar Council was encouraged to save the date of November 5, 2016 for a seminar called *Toolkit for Leaders* at Lord of Life Lutheran, in Maple Grove.
- Loaves and Fishes Renee Lea reported that long term, there will need to be more help with regard to the heavy work that goes into this ministry.
